What Passengers and Schedulers Should Know

Passengers:

Tell the doctor's office that you depend on All Points Transit for your transportation.

Medical Appointment Schedulers:

- Assist patients by scheduling appointments
 8am 2pm and not on the last Friday of the month
- Let your patient know about how long they can expect to be at your office. Remember that APT is a non-profit organization and is completely booked with rides every day. It is important that our passengers and drivers stay on schedule.
- Call APT Dispatch (Montrose: 240-9205, Delta: 874-7334) when the patient is finished with their appointment. Thank you for your partnership.

DIAL-A-RIDE



What is Dial-A-Ride?

Dial-A-Ride is a door-to-door transportation program, serving seniors and persons with disabilities in Montrose and Delta Counties as well as Norwood in San Miguel County.

DIAL-A-RIDE TRIP PRIORITIES:

- **MEDICAL:** to the doctor, dialysis and therapy appointments
- MEALS: to community centers & senior meal sites in Montrose, Olathe, Norwood, Nucla, Delta, Cedaredge, Hotchkiss and Paonia
 - **PERSONAL:** to the grocery store, the salon, post office, bank and more!

Rules to Remember On the Day of Your Ride

- **Bring cash** to pay for your ride. Drivers do not carry change and cannot accept tips.
- **Be ready to go** at least 10 minutes before your scheduled pick up time. The driver will not wait longer than 5 minutes after the scheduled pick up time.
- Only bring permitted items. Open drink containers, food and weapons are not allowed on the bus.
- Good manners are required. Passengers must not disturb others. Profanity is not allowed.
- Grocery bags are limited to 6 per passenger.
- **Don't forget to donate!** Your contribution will help us expand and improve service

Need to cancel?

Please call 24 hours in advance. If you do not cancel your ride at least 2 hours before your scheduled pick up time, your trip will be a "no show."

"No Show" Policy

If you are a "no show" 3 times in one month, All Points Transit may suspend your riding privileges for 30 days.

Becoming Inactive

If you do not ride with All Points Transit for over 4 months, you will no longer be an active passenger in the system.

Your 4-Step Guide on How to DIAL-A-RIDE

MAKE SURE YOU ARE PROGRAM ELIGIBLE*

Are you 60 years or older or a person of any age with a disability? If you answered yes, Dial-A-Ride is for you.

BECOME AN ACTIVE PASSENGER IN THE PROGRAM

To schedule a ride, you must be an active passenger in the system.

To get started call:

249-0128: Montrose County & Norwood

874-7334: Delta County

Currently, there is a waiting list for new passengers in the City of Montrose

PLAN YOUR TRIP

- Make sure you have no more than 3 stops on the same day
- Plan to travel between 6am and 4pm, Monday through Friday
- Be flexible. Rides are based on availability
- Remember: APT is not a taxi service. This means you may have to share your ride with other passengers, ride a little longer or get to your appointment a bit early. We're all in this together!
- Note that APT does not provide Dial-A-Ride service on the last Friday of the month.

CALL TO SCHEDULE YOUR RIDE WELL IN ADVANCE

The more notice you give us, the better service we can provide:

- Call at least 24 hours in advance
- Rides in Montrose are booked up to 2 weeks ahead

When to call:

- Call between 7am and 4pm, Monday through Friday
- Calls not taken on weekends or holidays
- Rides must be booked by 1:30pm on the previous business day (if you are scheduling for Monday, call by 1:30pm the Friday before)

When on the phone, let us know:

- Details of your pick up (where, when, why).
- How long you expect to be at your stop
- If you need to make more than one stop (limit 3)
- If this will be one trip or "round trip" (considered two trips)
- If you have any special needs
- If you have Medicaid (have your number ready)
- If an aide will be traveling with you (have their name and DOB)



Regional Trips

- Trips to Grand Junction from Montrose, Delta and the West End: \$10 each way (\$20 round trip)*
- Trips to Montrose from Nucla / Naturita / Norwood: \$10 each way (\$20 round trip)*
- Trips to Delta from Paonia, Hotchkiss, and Cedaredge: \$5 each way (\$10 round trip)*

*Rates are a suggested donation for seniors 60+

Call for current schedule and availability.

LOCAL TRIP DIAL-A-RIDE RATES

(within local trip areas – see map)

SENIORS 60+:

Seniors ride for a suggested donation: \$2 each way, \$4 Round Trip

- 10 trip ticket cards available for \$20
- 20 trip ticket cards available for \$40

Donations of any amount welcome. Please donate to help continue and improve service.

PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES: \$5 each way, \$10 round trip





MEDICAID PARTICIPANTS: Authorized Medicaid participants may travel at no cost.

PASSENGERS IN OUTLYING AREAS

- If you live outside main town centers, you may be asked for a larger donation
- Scheduling depends on current routes and availability.
